A discession followed and a vote was taken. Three "Yes" votes and twelve "No" votes resulted. A motion was made by Mr. Cartwright and seconded by Joe Jassionouski that Mr. Cuthill should attend the hearing to represent the Pinon Hills Chamber at the meeting and presnt their wishes.

New Business: At the Board of Director's meeting the suggested Budget for 1968 for the Chamber was \$380.00, was presneted by Prsident Jack Grant. Motion to approve this budget was made by Drew Park, Seconded by Jack King. Motion carried.
